WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," due to the anticipated economic crisis and related budgetary concerns resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Ohio's Stay at Home Order; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employees; and

WHEREAS, the current Residential Plans Examiner is being moved to a bargaining unit position of Building Inspector, leaving the Residential Plans Examiner position vacant; and

WHEREAS, on 6/18/20, the Human Resource Commission issued Order No. 20-01, which adopted the revisions and upgrade of the classification of Residential Plans Examiner, Category 3, Grade 5, Class Code 35061 to the classification of Residential Building Official, Category 3, Grade 6, Class Code 35061; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County Executive to fill the vacated Residential Building Official position in order for the Division of Building Standards to operate efficiently; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to hire a new Residential Building Official;
