7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a lease-purchase agreement**  
8 **with the Jack Doheny Company, at State Term Pricing, for a five-year term, at 2.49%, for**  
9 **a 2020 Peterbilt Chassis with a Vactor Combination Sewer Cleaner, which will be financed**  
10 **through The Huntington Public Capital Corporation, for a total amount not to exceed**  
11 **\$478,410.70 with a guaranteed trade-in of \$177,442.00 at the end of the lease, for a net lease**  
12 **cost of \$300,968.70, for the County Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and**  
13 **declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, Combination Sewer Cleaner Vehicles allow the sewer maintenance crews  
16 from the County Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services ("DSSS") to quickly  
17 remove sewer line blockages and clean sanitary sewer lines and pump station wet wells; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Combination Sewer Cleaner Vehicles are used daily and are critical in  
20 maintaining service to customers, to properly maintain sewers and to meet Ohio Environmental  
21 Protection Agency requirements; and

23 WHEREAS, DSSS has four Combination Sewer Cleaner Vehicles in its fleet, one of  
24 which Combination Sewer Cleaner Vehicles' lease will soon expire; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends entering into a lease-purchase agreement  
27 with the Jack Doheny Company, at State Term Pricing, for a five-year term at, 2.49%, for a 2020  
28 Peterbilt Chassis with a Vactor Combination Sewer Cleaner, which will be financed through The  
29 Huntington Public Capital Corporation, for five annual lease payments of \$60,193.74 for a total  
30 lease amount not exceed \$478,410.70, with a guaranteed trade-in of \$177,442.00 at the end of  
31 the lease, for a net lease cost of \$300,968.70; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its May 27, 2020 meeting, awarded said lease-  
34 purchase agreement with a lease-purchase agreement with the Jack Doheny Company, at State  
35 Term Pricing, for a five-year term, for a 2020 Peterbilt Chassis with a Vactor Combination  
36 Sewer Cleaner, which will be financed through The Huntington Public Capital Corporation, for  
37 five annual lease payments of \$60,193.74 for a total lease amount not exceed \$478,410.70 with a  
38 guaranteed trade-in of \$177,442.00 at the end of the lease, for a net lease cost of \$300,968.70;

41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
42 that the aforementioned lease-purchase agreement with the Jack Doheny Company is necessary  
43 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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6 a Vactor Combination Sewer Cleaner, which will be financed through The Huntington Public  
7 Capital Corporation, for five annual lease payments of \$60,193.74, for a total lease amount not  
8 exceed \$478,410.70, with a guaranteed trade-in of \$177,442.00 at the end of the lease, for a net  
9 lease cost of \$300,968.70, is hereby confirmed, and the County Executive is hereby authorized to  
10 execute such lease-purchase agreement and any necessary related documents.

12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
16 provide the Department of Sanitary Sewer Services with the equipment necessary to continue  
17 servicing its customers and properly maintaining its sewer lines.

21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall  
23 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


