A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Executive's Office), and the County Executive, for the period 4/1/20 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in pay, for the County Executive's Department of Human Resources, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the County Executive and Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Executive's Office), for the period 4/1/20 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in pay; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement and any other necessary related documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Executive's Office), and the County Executive, for the period 4/1/20 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in pay and any other necessary documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Executive's Office), and the County Executive.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
