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7 **A Resolution declaring the storm damage to the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run,**
8 **located in the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1, to be an emergency pursuant to**
9 **Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and confirming**
10 **an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Kenmore Construction**
11 **Co., Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$259,584.01, for the emergency repair of the Riverview**
12 **Road Bridge over Slipper Run, and any agreements necessary to accept emergency grant**
13 **funding available from the State of Ohio or the Federal Highway Administration, for the**
14 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, during a May 25, 2020 storm, 2.5 inches of rain fell in approximately 40
17 minutes, causing a water surge in Slipper Run under the Riverview Road Bridge (PNV-009-
18 1180), located in the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1; and

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20 WHEREAS, a fallen tree in Slipper Run washed into the culvert/stone arch-type bridge
21 over Slipper Run, blocking the regular flow of water; and

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23 WHEREAS, the blockage and additional flow of storm water forced the upstream end of
24 the structure and dislodging of the culvert pipe portion of the stone arch bridge to bend upward
25 and disconnect from the stone arch portion of the structure, blocking the flow of Slipper Run;
26 and

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28 WHEREAS, in addition to structural damage, the resulting 20 feet or more high-water
29 blockage caused the embankment to become saturated and to wash downstream, creating the
30 potential for the roadway to become unstable, thereby creating an unsafe roadway condition; and

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32 WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined the damage to the Riverview Road
33 Bridge over Slipper Run to be a threat to public safety and has closed the bridge to traffic until
34 an emergency repair can be made; and

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36 WHEREAS, the County Engineer requested Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., to remove
37 the broken pipe blocking the stream on Friday, May 29, 2020 in order to prevent flooding from
38 causing further saturation of the embankment and has asked for a quote for the cost of the bridge
39 and embankment repair; and

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41 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its July 1, 2020 meeting, awarded a construction
42 contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., for the emergency repair of the Riverview Road
43 Bridge over Slipper Run, in an amount not to exceed \$259,584.01, subject to confirmation by
44 County Council; and

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46 WHEREAS, grant funding for the replacement of the Riverview Road Bridge over
47 Slipper Run may be available and the County Engineer intends to apply for said funding; and
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4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the damage to Riverview Road
5 Bridge over Slipper Run constitutes an emergency under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified
6 Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in
7 the best interest of the County to immediately authorize a construction contract with Kenmore
8 Construction Co., Inc., necessary to repair the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run and
9 authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to apply for and accept
10 grant funding from the State of Ohio and the Federal Highway Administration;

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12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
13 of Ohio, that;

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15 SECTION 1

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17 This Council hereby finds and determines that the aforementioned Riverview Road
18 Bridge over Slipper Run (PNV-009-1180) located in the Village of Peninsula, in Council District
19 1, constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3).

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21 SECTION 2

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23 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Kenmore Construction
24 Co., Inc., for the emergency repair of the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run, in an amount
25 not to exceed \$259,584.01, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized
26 to execute such construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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28 SECTION 3

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30 The County Executive is further authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply
31 for and accept grant funding for the emergency repair of the Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper
32 Run.

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34 SECTION 4

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to allow for the
38 immediate repair of Riverview Road Bridge over Slipper Run.

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40 SECTION 5

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall
44 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


