## SECTION 1

Pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, this Council hereby authorizes purchases by the County Executive from Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation, as a Best Practical Source, for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens in County offices in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000.00.

## **SECTION 2**

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of funds for purchases from Krumroy-Cozad Construction Corporation for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens in County offices and the undertaking of the project is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes necessary purchases for labor and materials to fabricate and install acrylic screens that will protect the public and County employees during the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
