A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to establish the Summit County CARES Utility Relief Program, in collaboration with the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services and Community Action Akron Summit, and to execute a grant agreement with Community Action Akron Summit in a total amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, utilizing funding received by the County under Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") and declaring such expenditure necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), for the County Executive, and declaring an emergency.

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WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has had a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of the residents of Summit County and has dramatically impacted many residents financially, rendering them unable to cover all of the normal expenses of living; and

WHEREAS, the County, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") and Community Action Akron Summit ("CAAS") have partnered to establish the Summit County CARES Utility Relief Program geared toward ensuring that Summit County residents who have been thus impacted are able to bring their delinquent utility bills current (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Program will be administered by CAAS in accordance with guidelines to be established by DJFS together with CAAS; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to make a grant to CAAS, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, from funding received under Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") to fund the Program with an effective date of July 1, 2020 and ending on December 30, 2020 or when the funding of the Program is fully expended, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to create the Utility Relief Program and to execute a grant agreement with CAAS in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 utilizing CARES Act funds; and

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that creating the Summit County CARES Utility Relief Program and authorizing the grant of an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 to provide utility bill relief to qualified Summit County Residents is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with Community Action Akron Summit ("CAAS") in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, to be paid from funds received from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), which will be used provide utility assistance to qualified Summit County residents, necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION 2

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This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$1,000,000.00 under the aforementioned agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to Summit County residents who have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the Summit County Cares Utility Relief Program can be commenced and completed as expeditiously as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
