7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422**
9 **Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$363,076.00 (for a cumulative increase of**
10 **50.3%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,084,857.05, for the County Engineer, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-452, which authorized
14 the County Executive to advertise as needed for bridge engineering and construction projects and
15 pavement maintenance projects, for the County Engineer's 2020 Capital Improvements Program,
16 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$5,290,750.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the County Executive proposed
19 entering into a construction contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422
20 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$721,781.05; and

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22 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-104, which
23 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Ronyak Paving,
24 Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed
25 \$721,781.05, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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27 WHEREAS, the City of New Franklin, which joined the County's 422 Regional
28 Resurfacing Program, has adopted a resolution authorizing the City to pay for the alternates that
29 were part of the bid package and resurface additional roads, which requires a change order to the
30 original contract; and

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32 WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned contract will be in an amount not
33 to exceed \$363,076.00 (for a cumulative increase of 50.3%), to be entirely paid by the City; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 8, 2020, awarded said Change
36 Order No. 1; and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to the construction contract with Ronyak Paving,
40 Inc. for a total amount not to exceed \$1,084,857.05, is necessary and in the best interest of the
41 County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
44 of Ohio, that;

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48 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a construction contract with
49 Ronyak Paving, Inc., for the 2020 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to
50 exceed \$363,076.00 (for a cumulative increase of 50.3%), for a total amount not to exceed

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6 \$1,084,857.05, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute
7 such Change Order No. 1 and any other necessary related documents.

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9 SECTION 2

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11 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
12 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
13 provide a necessary change order to the construction contract for the 2020 Summit County 422
14 Resurfacing Program.

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18 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
19 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall
20 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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24 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
25 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
26 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
27 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
28 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
