A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Hudson concerning the proposed multi-purpose trail to be constructed along the Valley View Road Bridge over Brandywine Creek, located in City of Hudson, Council District 1, for the County Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Valley View Road (a.k.a. County Highway 25) extends within the City of Hudson from the Northern Corporation line to State Route 91, Darrow Road crossing over Brandywine Creek at Bridge No. HUT-025-1083, a county owned and maintained structure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson desires to construct a new multi-purpose trail (the "Project") along this portion of Valley View Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson desires to construct a reinforced concrete barrier wall between the trail and the edge of the bridge as it crosses over Brandywine Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Project will positively impact both pedestrian, bicycle and vehicular traffic crossing the bridge; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute a Cooperative Agreement to set forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the design, construction, and maintenance of the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned Cooperative Agreement with the City of Hudson for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement and any other necessary related documents with the City of Hudson for the proposed multi-purpose trail to be constructed along the Valley View Road Bridge over Brandywine Creek, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said Cooperative Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the County Executive.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately allow
