WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division has received a State Fiscal Year 2021 Ohio Department of Youth Services Delinquent Care & Custody grant, in the amount of \$4,502,734.68, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, that allows local courts to develop or purchase a range of community based services to meet the needs of juvenile offenders or youth at risk of offending; and
WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 22, 2020, awarded professional service contracts with the providers set forth in Exhibit A, for delinquent care and custody grant services, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$934,634.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contracts with certain providers are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
SECTION 1
The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain providers, for delinquent care and custody grant services, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$934,634.00 is hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute the aforementioned professional service contracts and any necessary related documents with the providers set forth in Exhibit A.
SECTION 2
This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for delinquent care and custody grant services effective 7/1/20.
SECTION 3
Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
