7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for four bomb suits for the**
8 **Youngstown Bomb Squad and the Sheriff's Office, for an estimated total cost not to exceed**
9 **\$200,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of**
10 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, the County is the fiscal agent for the Law Enforcement State Homeland
13 Security Program ("LESHSP") grant for Ohio Homeland Security Region 5, which is comprised
14 of law enforcement agencies throughout 13 counties in northeast Ohio; and

15
16 WHEREAS, expenditures for the LESHSP grant are determined by an Advisory
17 Committee, which has recommended the purchase of four bomb suits, two for the Youngstown
18 Bomb Squad and two for the Sheriff's Office; and

19
20 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
21 requires this Council's authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids; and

22
23 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for two bomb suits for the
24 Youngstown Bomb Squad and two bomb suits for the Sheriff's Office for a total of four bomb
25 suits, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$200,000.00; and

27 WHEREAS, said equipment will be fully grant-funded; and

29 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;
30 and

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
33 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
34 advertise for bids for bomb suits for the Youngstown Bomb Squad and the Sheriff's Office;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
37 of Ohio, that;

41 The Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for two bomb suits for the Youngstown
42 Bomb Squad and two bomb suits for the Sheriff's Office for a total of four bomb suits, for an
43 estimated total cost not to exceed \$200,000.00.

47 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
48 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
49 Executive to immediately advertise for bids in order to procure the necessary equipment within
50 the grant performance period.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


