An amended Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, of Change Order No. 3 to a professional service contract with Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs, LLC to provide legal representation and services to Kassim Ahmed in a lawsuit, <u>Holly Trivett Fisher, et al. v. The Summit County Prosecutor's Office, et al.</u>, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 \$25,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 400%), for a total amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County is required to provide legal representation and services to Kassim Ahmed pursuant to Section 2744.07(A) of the Ohio Revised Code in a lawsuit, <u>Holly Trivett Fisher, et al. v. The Summit County Prosecutor's Office, et al.</u>, Case No. CV-2018-07-2848 before Visiting Judge Janet R. Burnside (the "Lawsuit"), in the Court of Common Pleas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 244-18, which awarded a professional service contract with Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs, LLC to provide legal representation and services to Kassim Ahmed in the Lawsuit, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 392-18, which awarded Change Order No. 1 to said professional service contract with Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 100%), for a total amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-360, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to said professional service contract with Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 200%), for a total amount not to exceed \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, additional legal representation and services by Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs, LLC are necessary in the Lawsuit, now that the Defendants' Motion to Dismiss was partially overturned on appeal, Case No. CA-29340, before the Ninth District Court of Appeals and returned to the Court of Common Pleas; and
