A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a settlement agreement and release, for an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, to settle any and all claims arising out of or concerning issues raised in the claim brought on behalf of the Estate of Brittany Rae Berry also known as Brittany Rae Schlarb, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Estate of Brittany Rae Berry also known as Brittany Rae Schlarb ("the Estate") brought a claim against the County of Summit, concerning the death of Ms. Schlarb while she was incarcerated in the Jail (the "Claim"); and

WHEREAS, in consultation with outside counsel, the Executive and the Sheriff have reached terms of settlement with the Administrator of the Estate through her legal counsel to settle the Claim, for an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the settlement agreement and release, the Estate will settle the Claim and forever discharge the County and all related parties from any and all claims against them; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to settle the Claim for an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, for the aforementioned reason;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a settlement agreement and release for an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, to settle any and all claims arising out of or concerning issues raised in (the "Claim"). The settlement agreement shall include a release and discharge by the Estate of Brittany Rae Berry also known as Brittany Rae Schlarb of any and all claims against the County of Summit and all related parties.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately settling any and all claims arising out of or concerning issues raised in the Claim against the County and all related parties.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
