7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with**
8 **the Metro Regional Transit Authority to provide transportation to employment and**
9 **training related activities for work mandated recipients for a one-year term, from 10/1/20**
10 **through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to
14 enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Metro Regional Transit Authority ("Metro")
15 to provide transportation services for work mandated recipients of Temporary Assistance to
16 Needy Families ("TANF") and Food Assistance Employment Training ("FAET") and Medicaid
17 participants, for a one-year term, from 10/1/20 to 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed
18 \$125,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, said services will be utilized for transportation to employment and training
21 related activities; and

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23 WHEREAS, under this agreement, DJFS will dispense Metro transit cards, 31 day passes
24 and one day passes to clients for access to regular line services, which will be billed to DJFS;
25 and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
28 that authorizing the Executive to execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with
29 the Metro is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that:

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34 SECTION 1

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36 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement and any
37 other necessary related documents with the Metro Regional Transit Authority to provide
38 transportation to employment and training related activities for work mandated recipients for a
39 one-year term, from 10/1/20 through 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00.

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43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
44 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
45 provide for transportation services effective 10/1/20.
