A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a grant agreement with the City of Fairlawn for \$6,500,000.00 for the design and construction of a fiber-optic network to connect the Summit County Jail, various courthouses, policing agencies and social services providers as a part of the Summit County Criminal Justice Technology Project, for the Executive and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic is a health crisis that requires the different Courts in the County and the County Sheriff to change the method by which they conduct hearings for individuals held in the Summit County Jail as well as those who have posted a bond; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has also created the need for investments by the County in previously unplanned capital projects that will afford the Courts and the Sheriff the ability to safely and efficiently work remotely in light of the pandemic while improving their operations and ensuring that defendants' and inmates' constitutional rights are fully protected while maintaining a safe and socially distant environment; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act") was passed by Congress and signed into law on March 27, 2020, to provide economic relief and to protect the American people from the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19 and as part of this Act, the County received funds to expend to abate the pandemic with the community; and

WHEREAS, this Council passed legislation on June 29, 2020 (Res. No. 2020-196) confirming a professional services contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc. for consulting and project management services for jail management and virtual courtroom systems, due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic (the "Project") and as part of MCM's analysis they have recommended that the County utilize broadband technology to connect Courts, public safety and social services agencies in a closed network to ensure the secure, and efficient continuation of criminal justice operations while maintaining the necessary safety protocols due to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairlawn ("Fairlawn") has created a municipal broadband utility, known as FairlawnGig, which has designed and constructed a fiber-optic network in Fairlawn and surrounding areas, and which will be managing the design and construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to use a portion of the funds received under the CARES Act to enter into a grant agreement with Fairlawn in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 for Fairlawn to design, construct, and install a new fiber optic network to connect the Summit County Jail and additional corrections facilities with a number of courthouses in Summit County and other law enforcement and social services agencies in the County in order to allow for improved and secure communications, video arraignments, and other remote communications as part of the Project to resolve certain operational problems created by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Fairlawn has agreed to use and expend the grant funds provided by the County to pay for the design, construction, installation and management of the Project subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Grant Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein as if fully restated, and in accordance with the guidance issued by the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to execute a grant agreement with the City of Fairlawn in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 for Fairlawn to design, construct, and install a new fiber optic network to connect those facilities defined in the Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 for the Grant Agreement with the City of Fairlawn is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with the City of Fairlawn, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 to design, construct, and install a new fiber optic network to connect those facilities defined in said agreement and to make any necessary modifications to said agreement under terms substantially similar and not materially adverse to the County that are otherwise consistent with the original agreement and to execute any documents necessary for completion of the Project.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$6,500,000.00 under the aforementioned agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately authorize a grant agreement with the City of Fairlawn that will afford all Courts and service providers within Summit County and the Sheriff the ability to safely and efficiently work remotely due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic while continuing to improve their operations ensure that defendants' and inmates' constitutional rights are protected.
