A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the Engineer to hire three bargaining unit Maintenance Workers at a base rate of pay of \$23.48 an hour and a post-probationary rate of pay of \$24.72 an hour, as replacements, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," due to the anticipated economic crisis and related budgetary concerns resulting from the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employees; and

WHEREAS, three Maintenance Workers have left or will be leaving County employment within the next three months, and the Engineer's Office needs to replace these three workers, as Maintenance Workers are critical positions for the operations of the Engineer's office by maintaining roads and performing snow and ice control; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Engineer to hire three Maintenance Workers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

RESOLUTION NO

This Council hereby determines that the Engineer has demonstrated that it is necessary for the effective and continued operation of his office to authorize the Engineer, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, to hire three Maintenance Workers, Classification D3641, at a base rate of pay of \$23.48 an hour and a post-probationary rate of pay of \$24.72 an hour, to be funded in full through the Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax fund.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Engineer to hire and train three Maintenance Workers in time for the snow and ice control season.
