A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a confidential settlement agreement and mutual release for an amount not to exceed \$70,482.50, to settle any and all claims related to Project Q-967, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive desires to execute a confidential settlement agreement and mutual release for an amount not to exceed \$70,482.50, to settle any and all claims related to Project Q-967, (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020, the Executive's department of Sanitary Sewer Services ("DSSS") alleges that payor caused a delay in the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, payor denies any and all liability for the alleged delays but agrees to fully reimburse the County if a confidential settlement agreement and mutual release is executed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 130.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Compromise of Small Claims," the Executive must seek authorization from this Council prior to accepting the settlement agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the confidential settlement agreement and mutual release for an amount not to exceed \$70,482.50, for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a confidential settlement agreement and mutual release, for an amount not to exceed \$70,482.50, to settle any and all claims related to Project Q-967. The Executive is further authorized to prepare and sign any other necessary documents related to this claim.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately settling all claims related to Project Q-967.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
