A Resolution certifying deferred sewer tap-in fees to the Fiscal Officer, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(f) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit authorizes the Director of the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services to establish procedures for a tap-in fee extended payment program enabling multiple residential, commercial and industrial users the option of placing part of their sewer tap-in fee on their property tax duplicate, without interest, for a period not to exceed two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(f) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit provides that said deferred fees are to be certified to the Fiscal Officer and placed on the property tax duplicate for collection; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that certifying the aforementioned charges to the Fiscal Officer is necessary and in the best interest of County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

 The sewer tap-in fees of the following participant in the County's extended payment program is hereby certified to the Fiscal Officer to be placed on the property tax list and duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected in the annual installments as stated below, payable semiannually without interest, as provided by Section 923.05 of the Codified Ordinances and Section 6117.02(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.
