WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that creating the Summit County COVID-19 Non-Profit Emergency Relief Grant Program and the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 to provide grants to qualified Summit County non-profit entities is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the expenditure of \$6,500,000.00 under the aforementioned grant agreement with ACF is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Akron Community Foundation ("ACF") in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000.00 to be paid from funds received pursuant to the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), which will be used to make grants to Summit County registered 501(c)(3) non-profit agencies through the Summit County COVID-19 Non-Profit Emergency Relief Grant Program (the "Program") to be divided with \$5,000,000.00 being used by ACF to make grants to non-profit agencies that help to provide for the basic needs of underserved members of the community and those most effected by COVID-19 and \$1,500,000.00 to be used to make grants to non-profit agencies that support the arts and cultural endeavors within the community.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$6,500,000.00 under the aforementioned grant agreement with the ACF is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to Summit County non-profit agencies that have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the same can be commenced and completed as expeditiously as possible.
