A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a				

A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. for engineering, design, and surveying services for the Q-836 Pump Stations 62, 63, and 82 Improvements Project, located in Coventry Township and the City of Tallmadge, in Council Districts 6 and 8, in an amount not to exceed \$275,016.00, (for a cumulative increase of 75.5%), for a total amount not to exceed \$639,433.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-472, which authorized the Executive to execute a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc., for engineering, design, and surveying services for the Q-836 Pump Stations 62, 63, and 82 Improvements Project (the "Project"), in an amount not to exceed \$364,417.00; and

WHEREAS, additional design services are necessary for the Project to cover the cost of designing new force mains, pump stations, and property acquisition services, resulting in the aforementioned cost increase; and

WHEREAS, the Project scope increased to address storm water storage and pumping around the sanitary sewer overflow in conjunction with needed improvements to minimize infiltration and inflow upstream from the sanitary sewer overflow; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the scope of services requires additional funds to be spent; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its September 16, 2020 meeting, awarded Change Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$275,016.00, (for a cumulative increase of 75.5%), for a total amount not to exceed \$639,433.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with DLZ Ohio, Inc., for engineering, design, and surveying services for the Q-836 Pump Stations 62, 63, and 82 Improvements Project (the "Project"), in an amount not to exceed \$275,016.00, (for a cumulative increase of 75.5%), for a total amount not to exceed \$639,433.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said change order and any other necessary related documents.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately confirm the award of a necessary change order to the professional service contract in order to cover the increased cost of design services essential to maintaining the Project's completion timeline.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
