A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Vasu Communications, Inc. for the purchase of mobile and portable radios and accessories for Portage, Trumbull and Wayne Counties, in an amount not to exceed \$107,149.13, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management—Division of Public Safety, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-207, which authorized the Executive to advertise for bids for mobile and portable radios and accessories for Portage, Trumbull and Wayne Counties as part of their Communications Interoperability Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing bids, the Executive selected Vasu Communications, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its September 16, 2020 meeting, awarded a purchase contract with Vasu Communications, Inc. for the purchase of mobile and portable radios and accessories for Portage, Trumbull and Wayne Counties, in an amount not to exceed \$107,149.13, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, the estimate of total cost was based upon figures submitted by Portage, Trumbull and Wayne Counties, which did not include additional costs for accessories such as chargers, microphones and installation kits and programming; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, the Ohio Region 5 Committee approved the original estimate without said additional costs; and

WHEREAS, because the bid by Vasu Communications, Inc. includes additional costs for accessories, its exceeds the estimated total cost by more than 10%, and accordingly, the approval of this Council is required pursuant to Section 177.02(c) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, said equipment will be fully grant-funded; and
