WHEREAS, in 2019, the Office of Information Technology determined that is was necessary to replace its BMC Footprints software with enterprise and security mobility ("ESM") and IT service automation ("ITSA") software from ServiceNow, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 4, 2019, awarded a purchase contract with ServiceNow, Inc. for 40 ESM software licenses for the Office of Information Technology and 4 ISTA software licenses for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, for a one-year term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$45,710.40; and
