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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **LexisNexis Risk Solutions, as a Sole Source, for CopLogic, a software tool that allows the**
9 **public to submit police reports online through a web based interface, in an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$103,500.00, and declaring such expenditure necessary due to the public health**
11 **emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), for the Executive's**
12 **Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, in response to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), first responders are
16 working on ways to continue to safely interact with their residents while providing the same
17 level of service and responsiveness; and

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19 WHEREAS, as part of that effort, the Executive's Department of Law and Risk
20 Management-Division of Public Safety is requesting that the County purchase from LexisNexis
21 Risk Solutions, as a Sole Source, CopLogic, a crime reporting software tool that allows members
22 of the public to submit police reports online through a web-based interface; and

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24 WHEREAS, CopLogic will enable support for the Sheriff's Office and the police
25 departments in Akron, Hudson, Twinsburg, and Stow; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its September 30, 2020 meeting, awarded a
28 purchase contract with LexisNexis Risk Solutions, as a Sole Source, for CopLogic, in an amount
29 not to exceed \$103,500.00; and

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31 WHEREAS, it is expected that the cost of the Project will be paid for by funding received
32 under Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES
33 Act"); and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that the aforementioned purchase contract with LexisNexis Risk Solutions is necessary and in the
37 best interest of the County of Summit;

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44 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with LexisNexis Risk

47 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any

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6 This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$103,500.00 under the
7 aforementioned agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the
8 COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the
9 federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act").

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11 SECTION 3

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13 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
14 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
15 authorizes a necessary contract to provide support for Summit County law enforcement.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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23 SECTION 5

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
28 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
29 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


