SECTION 1

 This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Akron/Summit Convention and Visitors Bureau ("ASCVB"), in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, to be paid from funds received from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), which will be used to provide financial assistance with expenses associated with the remarketing of the convention center and the tourism industry in Summit County, which have been impacted by the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of \$250,000.00 under the aforementioned grant agreement is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to the ASCVB with expenses associated with the remarketing of the convention center and the tourism industry in Summit County which have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the project can be commenced and completed as expeditiously as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
