WHEREAS, the Executive desires to provide additional support to these communities to help ensure their ability to maintain policing services throughout the COVID-19 and post COVID-19 timeframe; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to provide a 2nd round of County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grants with the Cities of Akron and Barberton to support policing efforts in Summit County and to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned grant agreements with these communities; and

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a 2nd round of County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant agreements with the Cities of Akron, in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.00, and Barberton in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, to support policing efforts in Summit County, and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 under the aforementioned program is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to Summit County political subdivisions that have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the same can maintain public safety and public health forces at a level necessary to effectively respond to the pandemic.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
