WHEREAS, this Council previously approved resolution 2020-180, creating the County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program and authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$35,000,000.00; and		
WHEREAS, the County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program (the "Program") is intended to provide funding to support COVID-19 response related activities being engaged in by public safety and public health employees; and		
WHEREAS, eligible expenses include wage and benefit costs associated with public health and public safety employees, pursuant to the guidance issued by Treasury pursuant to Section 5001 of the federal CARES Act for the period 3/1/2020 to 12/30/2020; and		
WHEREAS, the University of Akron ("the University") faced economic and budgetary pressures prior to COVID-19, which have become exacerbated by the pandemic and its anticipated long-term economic and budgetary impact; and		
WHEREAS, the City of Akron has also been impacted by the national phenomenon of increasing violent crime and increased gun violence and gun related activity; and		

WHEREAS, the University of Akron Police Department patrols the residential

neighborhoods surrounding the University and plays an integral role in keeping the students who live in those neighborhoods safe as well as contributing to the overall well-being of the City and

University; and

WHEREAS, the Executive desires to provide additional support to the University to help ensure their ability to maintain policing services throughout the COVID-19 and post COVID-19 timeframe; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit a County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant to the University of Akron to support policing efforts in Summit County and to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned grant agreement with the University; and

WHEREAS, this Council further finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 is necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal CARES Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute a County of Summit COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant agreement with the University of Akron, in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00, to support policing efforts in Summit County, and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 under the aforementioned program is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act").

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to the University of Akron which has been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic so that the same can maintain public safety and public health forces at a level necessary to effectively respond to the pandemic.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
