A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract for the purchase of 2 SurfacePro 5 LTEs and 91 Microsoft Surface Laptop 3s through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services' Technology and Service Support Policy, in an amount not to exceed \$140,731.17, and declaring such expenditure necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-076, which authorizes the Executive, by Executive Order, to temporarily modify, as necessary, sections of Chapter 169 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Personnel Policies and Procedures", in order that appointing authorities of the County of Summit shall have the necessary flexibility to address the operational impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 020-055 created the ability for appointing authorities to assign essential personnel as essential-work from home during the Public Health Emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Child Support Enforcement Agency ("CSEA") desires to ensure that it has sufficient informational technology equipment for use by its employees working remotely; and

WHEREAS, CSEA desires to purchase 2 SurfacePro 5 LTEs and 91 Microsoft Surface Laptop 3s through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") Technology and Service Support Policy ("TSSP"), in an amount not to exceed \$140,731.17, which will be used by employees working remotely; and

WHEREAS, this expenditure will utilize Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 14, 2020, awarded, approved by the IT Board on September 10, 2020, a purchase contract for the purchase of 2 SurfacePro 5 LTEs and 91 Microsoft Surface Laptop 3s through the ODJFS' TSSP, in an amount not to exceed \$140,731.17, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that aforementioned purchase contract and any other documents necessary for the purchase of the aforementioned equipment through ODJFS is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit and that the expenditure is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control, approved by the IT Board on September 10, 2020, of a purchase contract for the purchase of 2 SurfacePro 5 LTEs and 91 Microsoft Surface Laptop 3s through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") Technology and Service Support Policy ("TSSP"), in an amount not to exceed \$140,731.17, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure for 2 SurfacePro LTEs and 91 Microsoft Surface Laptop 3s through the ODJFS' TSSP, in an amount not to exceed \$140,731.17, is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act").

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for necessary computer equipment for use by Child Support Enforcement Agency employees to continue to provide necessary services for their clients.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
