A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the IT Board, of a professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp. for hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings and related services for Summit County criminal justice stakeholders, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00, and declaring such expenditure necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has made it necessary to implement virtual courtroom proceedings to limit personal contact during said proceedings; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No 2020-196, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for consulting and project management services for jail management and virtual courtroom systems, due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, in an amount not to exceed \$145,189.40; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2020, the County issued a Request for Proposals for hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings and related services for Summit County criminal justice stakeholders, including, but not limited to, the municipal courts in Akron, Barberton and Stow, the Court of Common Pleas, the Prosecutor's Office, the office of the Legal Defenders of Summit County, Ohio, Inc., the Akron Bar Association, Oriana House, Inc. and the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, after the Request for Proposals period closed on October 19, 2020, the County had received three proposals and after evaluation by MCM Consulting Group, Inc., the County has selected ExhibitOne Corp. as the only responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtrooms proceedings and related services will be funded through the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 4, 2020, awarded, subject to the approval of the IT Board, a professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp. for hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings and related services in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp., Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, this Council further declares that the expenditure of funds totaling \$5,000,000.00, for the aforementioned professional service contract with ExhibitOne, Corp. is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal CARES Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the IT Board, of a professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp. for hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings and related services for Summit County criminal justice stakeholders, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of up to \$5,000,000.00 for the aforementioned professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp., Inc. is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and is being done in compliance with the provisions of Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act").

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately limit personal contact in the courtroom due to COVID-19 by implementing county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
