7 **An Amended Resolution approving and adopting the 2021 operating budget for all funds,**
8 **departments and agencies of the County of Summit and appropriating funds totaling**
9 **~~\$569,266,570.00~~ \$476,751,084.00 as set forth in Amended Exhibit A, for the Executive's**
10 **Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council's duties include the adoption of an annual operating budget for
13 the County of Summit; and

14
15 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
16 approving and adopting the 2021 full operating budget for all funds, departments and agencies of
17 the County of Summit, as set forth in Amended Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and
18 incorporated herein as if fully restated, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
19 Summit;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

24 SECTION 1

25
26 The 2021 full operating budget for all funds, departments and agencies for the County of
27 Summit, as set forth in Amended Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein
28 as if fully restated is hereby approved and adopted.

29
30 SECTION 2

31
32 This Resolution will constitute approval for the Fiscal Officer to do any of the following
33 for the 2021 fiscal year:

34
35 (a) Make any of the following interfund transfers:

- 36
37 (1) Transfer money from the General Fund to any other fund of the County.
38
39 (2) Transfer money to any internal service fund from any other fund of the
40 County from which the obligations being paid by that internal service fund
41 are properly payable and transfer money from any internal service fund
42 back to the appropriate fund.
43

44 (b) If this Resolution is enacted with the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
45 members of this Council, make any of the following interfund transfers:

- 46
47 (1) Transfer the unexpended balance in a bond fund that is no longer needed
48 for the purpose for which that fund was created to the Bond Retirement
49 Fund.
50 (2) Transfer the unexpended balance in any specific permanent improvement
51 fund, other than a bond fund, after the payment of all obligations incurred
52 in the acquisition of that improvement:

4 (A) To the Bond Retirement Fund, or

5
6 (B) If that money is not required to meet the obligations payable from
7 the Bond Retirement Fund, to a special fund for the acquisition of
8 permanent improvements, including the Capital Projects Fund, or
9 with the approval of the Summit County Court of Common Pleas,
10 to the General Fund.

11
12 (3) Transfer the unexpended balance in any special fund, other than an
13 improvement fund, to the General Fund or to the Bond Retirement Fund
14 after the termination of the activity, service, or other undertaking for
15 which that special fund existed, but only after the payment of all
16 obligations incurred and payable from that special fund.

17
18 (4) Transfer moneys retained or received under Section 4501.04 or Section
19 5735.27(A)(3), Revised Code (relating to motor vehicle and motor fuel
20 taxes, respectively) to the Bond Retirement Fund if any principal, interest,
21 or charges for which those moneys may be used are payable from the
22 Bond Retirement Fund.

23
24 (c) Create new funds in the County's chart of accounts as needed.

25
26 SECTION 3

27
28 The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within appropriations as
29 set forth in Amended Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully
30 restated.

31
32 SECTION 4

33
34 For Fiscal Year 2021, each member of the County of Summit Human Resource
35 Commission shall be compensated at a bi-weekly rate of \$342.43, with no fringe benefits, to be
36 paid in 26 equal payments.

37
38 SECTION 5

39
40 The Executive's Department of Finance and Budget shall submit to this Council a report
41 of actual monthly revenues and expenditures for each County department, office, agency,
42 authority, board and commission on an annual basis, to be in compliance with Section 2.03(8)(c)
43 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

45 SECTION 6

47 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
48 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that the
49 appropriations contained in Exhibit A are immediately needed for operations of the County.
