7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, entitled “Temporary Hiring Freeze,” to authorize the Engineer to hire an**  
9 **Engineering Intern at a rate of pay between \$15.45 and \$21.61 an hour, for the Engineer,**  
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

12 ~~WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted~~  
13 ~~Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, “Temporary~~  
14 ~~Hiring Freeze,” in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Ohio’s Stay at Home~~  
15 ~~Order; and~~

16  
17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that  
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and  
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire  
20 said employee(s); and

21  
22 WHEREAS, the Engineer’s Office provides paid internships to two engineering students  
23 from the University of Akron, and one of the current interns is unavailable to continue the  
24 Engineering Intern position during the spring semester causing the vacancy to be filled; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, the Engineer states that it is necessary for the continued and effective  
27 operation of the Engineer’s Office to be permitted to hire a replacement Engineering Intern to  
28 work during the spring semester; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
31 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Engineer to  
32 hire an Engineering Intern;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
35 State of Ohio, that:

37 SECTION 1

39 This Council hereby finds and determines that the Engineer has demonstrated that it is  
40 necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office to authorize the Engineer,  
41 pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, to hire an  
42 Engineering Intern, Classification #61021, at a rate of pay of between \$15.45 and \$21.61 an  
43 hour, to be funded in full through the Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax fund.

47 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
48 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
49 authorize the Engineer to hire an Engineering Intern in time to align with the University of  
50 Akron’s spring semester.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


