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7 **A Resolution authorizing various service rates to be charged by the Sheriff for the years**
8 **2021, 2022 and 2023, and authorizing the Executive to execute contracts for the Sheriff for**
9 **said services for the period 1/1/2021 through 12/31/2023, for the Executive and the Sheriff,**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Summit County Sheriff's Office has historically provided various
13 services to various public and private entities, including patrol services, security and traffic
14 services and the use of the Sheriff's firing ranges; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County wishes to utilize the service rate schedule, which is referenced
17 below, for these various services for calendar years 2021, 2022 and 2023; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council last authorized the fee schedule for use of the firing range at the
20 Sheriff Robert D. Campbell Training Facility on March 20, 2017 in Resolution No. 2017-089;
21 and

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23 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 505.43 and 737.04, the Sheriff has
24 authority to provide policing services to Summit County townships and municipal corporations
25 including both cities and villages; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council has determined that the Executive should be authorized to
28 execute contracts for the Sheriff for any of these various services at the rates contained herein;
29 and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the various
33 service rates to be charged by the Sheriff for calendar years 2021, 2022 and 2023, and
34 authorizing the Executive to execute contracts for said services;

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36 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize various service rates to be charged by the Sheriff and to authorize the Executive to execute service contracts for services provided by the Sheriff and any necessary related documents.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

8 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
9 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
10 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
11 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


