7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Avenu Insights & Analytics, as a Best Practical Source, for Banner maintenance, for a one-**
9 **year term, from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, an amount not to exceed \$222,042.16, for the**
10 **Fiscal Officer and the Office of Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Avenu Insights & Analytics has experience with the existing Banner
13 system, has an in-depth understanding of Banner and integrations with other mission critical
14 systems and possesses other specific knowledge that other potential vendors do not possess,
15 making it a Best Practical Source; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting on November 18, 2020, awarded,
18 approved by the IT Board on November 5, 2020, a purchase contract with Avenu Insights &
19 Analytics, as a Best Practical Source, for Banner maintenance, for a one-year term, from 1/1/21
20 through 12/31/21, in an amount not to exceed \$222,042.16, subject to the approval of the IT
21 Board and confirmation by this Council; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Avenu Insights & Analytics is necessary and in
25 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Avenu Insights &
33 Analytics, as a Best Practical Source, approved by the IT Board on November 5, 2020, for
34 Banner maintenance, for a one-year term, from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, in an amount not to
35 exceed \$222,042.16, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute such
36 purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
41 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately
42 approving necessary maintenance of the Banner system effective 1/1/21.

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44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


