7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award of a Justice Assistance Grant Victim Advocacy Grant from the Ohio**  
9 **Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, for the period 1/1/16**  
10 **through 12/31/16, in the amount of \$8,333.32, with a 75% local cash match requirement, in**  
11 **the amount of \$24,999.95, and a supplemental cash match amount of \$8,296.58 required for**  
12 **certain employment expenditures not covered by the grant, and appropriating funds in the**  
13 **amount of \$41,629.85 for 2016, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, has  
16 awarded a Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) Victim Advocacy Grant of federal funds, for the  
17 period 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in the amount of \$8,333.32, with a 75% local cash match  
18 requirement, in the amount of \$24,999.95; and

20 WHEREAS, an additional local cash match of \$8,296.58, for a total match of \$33,296.53,  
21 is needed to cover the program’s additional personnel costs, including that of the employee’s  
22 hospital waiver and life insurance as these items are not covered under the grant guidelines; and

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24 WHEREAS, the local cash match funds are appropriated in the County Prosecutor’s  
25 General Fund 2016 operating budget, identified in Resolution No. 2015-496; and

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27 WHEREAS, this annual funding supports a victim advocate position in order to provide  
28 the mandated services to victims of crime; and

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30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
31 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
32 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio  
33 Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
36 of Ohio, that:

38 SECTION 1

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40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
41 the Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) award from the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of  
42 Criminal Justice Services, for the period 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in the amount of \$8,333.32,  
43 with a 75% local cash match requirement, in the amount of \$24,999.95. The expenditure of a  
44 supplemental cash match amount of \$8,296.58, needed to cover the program’s additional  
45 personnel costs, including that of the employee’s hospital waiver and life insurance not covered  
46 under the grant guidelines, is hereby authorized.
