WHEREAS, Section 109.802 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for a formula reimbursement of continuing professional training costs through the Ohio Attorney General's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General's Office has issued a payment in the amount of \$34,160.00 to the Sheriff's office as reimbursement for training costs, and the fund balance prior to receiving this check was \$17,337.36, bringing the cash balance in the fund to \$51,497.36; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests that \$35,000.00 in continuing professional training funds be appropriated for training and equipment expenses related to continuing professional training; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned continuing professional training reimbursement funds received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, in the amount of \$35,000.00;
