A Resolution authorizing the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions to be held in 2016, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety conducts various training and planning sessions, including domestic preparedness steering committee workshops and law enforcement, fire, dispatch and emergency medical services personnel training, for the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, such training sessions are attended by county employees, public safety personnel, outside organizations and elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety wishes to pay hospitality expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00, for 2016 related to the aforementioned training sessions, all of which are paid for through various grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Ohio issued Opinion No. 82-006, which authorizes the expenditure of funds by a local political subdivision for its employees as long as those expenditures are necessary to further a public purpose and if the political subdivision's determination to make such expenditures is not manifestly arbitrary or unreasonable; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.24 (b) and (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit require the approval of County Council for hospitality expenditures exceeding \$2,000.00 per year and for hospitality expenditures for purposes other than employee training, meetings and organization strategic planning meetings; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2016 and that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose;
