A Resolution designating the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services as the lead agency to oversee the administration of the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 305.190 of the Amended Substitute House Bill 64 of the 131st General Assembly, the state's biennial budget, creates the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program, to provide employment, training and other supportive services to mandatory and voluntary program participants ages 16 to 24 based upon a comprehensive assessment of an individual's employment and training needs; and

WHEREAS, each County is required by Section 305.190 no later than May 15, 2016 to designate either the county department of job and family services or the workforce development agency that serves the county as the lead agency responsible for administering the program and meeting performance goals established by the State; and

WHEREAS, the effective date for the implementation of the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program shall be July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to designate the Department of Job and Family Services as the lead agency to oversee the administration of the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive's Department of Job and Family Services is hereby designated as the lead agency to oversee the administration of the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of timely designating the County's lead agency for the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program before a recommended March 1, 2016 deadline in order to administer the program beginning July 1, 2016.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
