A Resolution amending Resolution No. 2014-173 to authorize the County Executive to apply for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement in an amount not to exceed \$1,333,342.50 for the Pump Station No. 6 Sewer Force Main Replacement Phase 3 Project Q-325-3, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, in the Pump Station No. 6 Sewer Force Main Replacement Phase 3 Project Q-325-3 ("Project"), certain sections of said pipeline along Fishcreek and Marsh Roads will be replaced, due to prematurely corrosion in the existing lines due to high concentrations of hydrogen sulfide gas; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2014-173, Council authorized the Executive to apply for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement in an amount not to exceed \$1,210,650.00 to finance the construction of the Pump Station No. 6 Sewer Force Main Replacement Phase 3 Project Q-325-3 ("Project"), located in the City of Stow, Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2015-530, Council awarded the construction contract for the Project in the amount of \$1,269,850.00 to Lockhart Excavating Company; and

WHEREAS, this Council find and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Resolution No. 2014-173 to authorize a loan not to exceed \$1,333,342.50 to reflect the cost of the construction contract of \$1,269,850.00 as awarded in Resolution 2015-530, and the 5% contingency as allowed by the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby amends Resolution No. 2014-173 to authorize the County Executive to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan agreement, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority in an amount not to exceed \$1,333,342.50 to finance the construction of the Pump Station No. 6 Sewer Force Main Replacement Phase 3 Project Q-325-3 ("Project"), located in Council District 3.

SECTION 2

That Section 2 of Resolution No. 2014-173 is hereby amended to state that it is estimated that the total cost of Project will not exceed \$1,333,342.50, including a 5% contingency and the interest rate for the 20-year WPCLF loan shall not exceed 4 percent per year. The dedicated source of repayment will be the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund.
