7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a vendor to**
8 **provide payroll services for the 2016 Summer Youth Employment Program, for the period**
9 **of 5/1/16 to 9/30/16, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,372,500.00, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a vendor to provide
16 payroll services for the 2016 Summer Youth Employment Program, for the period of 5/1/16 to
17 9/30/16, for a total estimated cost not to exceed \$2,372,500.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is attached as Exhibit A; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
23 advertise for bids for the aforementioned services;

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25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a vendor to provide payroll
31 services for the 2016 Summer Youth Employment Program, for the period of 5/1/16 to 9/30/16,
32 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,372,500.00.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
38 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for payroll services for the 2016 Summer Youth
39 Employment Program, effective 5/1/16.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
