## SECTION 1

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the resurfacing of Medina Line Road from State Route 18 to Granger Road, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5 ("Project").

## **SECTION 2**

The terms of the Local Public Agency agreement shall include the following:

- a. That the parties estimate the Project's construction cost to be \$959,500.00; and
- b. That the net estimated cost to the County of Summit shall be an amount not to exceed \$207,900.00; and
- c. That the County of Summit shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Project; and
- d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County of Summit may commence competitive bidding activities for Project construction, with award of contract subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by this Council; and

## **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately completes a prerequisite for the Project to proceed in a timely manner in 2016.

## **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
