7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency**
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for the resurfacing of**
9 **Medina Line Road from SR 18 to Granger Road, located in Bath Township, at a net cost to**
10 **the County not to exceed \$207,900.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the County Engineer finds a public need for the resurfacing of Medina Line
13 Road from State Route 18 to Granger Road, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5
14 ("Project"); and

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16 WHEREAS, the Project's estimated total cost for construction, construction engineering
17 and inspection ("Project's Construction Cost") is \$959,500.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration has committed \$751,600.00 towards
20 the Project's construction costs; and

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22 WHEREAS, the County of Summit plans to provide the remaining of the Project's
23 Construction Cost, in an amount not to exceed \$207,900.00, to be paid from Motor Vehicle Gas
24 Tax Funds; and

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26 WHEREAS, State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the County
27 Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement, to confirm the Project's
28 construction cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of
29 competitive bidding, construction and construction engineering of the Project; and

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31 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
32 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter, authorizes the County Executive to
33 execute such agreements, subject to the approval of County Council; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Local Public Agency agreement will cite that up to a maximum of
36 \$959,500.00 will be provided to the Project from the Federal Highway Administration's Surface
37 Transportation Program's Resurfacing fund as administered by AMATS; and

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39 WHEREAS, no funds will be expended for the Project's construction until and unless
40 authorized by separate Resolutions; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that authorizing the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency agreement with ODOT
44 for the Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency agreement
10 with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the resurfacing of Medina
11 Line Road from State Route 18 to Granger Road, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5
12 ("Project").

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14 SECTION 2

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16 The terms of the Local Public Agency agreement shall include the following:

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18 a. That the parties estimate the Project's construction cost to be \$959,500.00; and
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20 b. That the net estimated cost to the County of Summit shall be an amount not to exceed
21 \$207,900.00; and
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23 c. That the County of Summit shall provide all other financial resources necessary to
24 fully complete the Project; and
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26 d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County of Summit may
27 commence competitive bidding activities for Project construction, with award of
28 contract subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, said
29 ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by this Council; and
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31 SECTION 3

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
35 completes a prerequisite for the Project to proceed in a timely manner in 2016.

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37 SECTION 4

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39 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
40 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
41 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
