WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 291-14, which awarded a professional service contract with Roetzel & Andress, LPA to provide legal representation and services to the County of Summit related to a lawsuit, Lyn Watters v. Summit County, Ohio, et al., Case No. 5:14-CV-2390, before Magistrate Judge George J. Limbert in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-141, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned professional service contract, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 (for an increase of 100%), for a total amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council also previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-350, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to the aforementioned professional service contract, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 (200% cumulative increase), for a total amount not to exceed \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its March 30, 2016 meeting, awarded Change Order No. 3 to said professional service contract, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 (400% cumulative increase), for a total amount not to exceed \$125,000.00, subject to confirmation by Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 3 to the aforementioned professional service contract with Roetzel & Andress, LPA, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00;
