## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with the City of Stow for reimbursement/payment of construction costs for the Mud Brook Restoration Project, in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in a total amount not to exceed \$65,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately reimburse the City of Stow for costs incurred in 2016 associated with the Mud Brook Restoration Project, in the City of Stow, in Council District 3.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
