A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract to Maximus Consulting Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal programs, for a three-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$57,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 066-14, which awarded a professional service contract to Maximus Consulting Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal Programs, for the County's Fiscal Year ending 12/31/15, with four options to renew, in an amount not to exceed \$19,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 230-15, which awarded a renewal of a professional service contract to Maximus Consulting Services, as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal programs, for the County's Fiscal Year ending 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$19,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to forgo the additional three options to renew with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc. and enter into a professional service contract with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal programs, for a three-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, for the County's Fiscal Years ending 12/31/17, 12/31/18, and 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$57,000.00, for a cost savings to the County of \$2,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 4, 2016, awarded a professional service contract to Maximus Consulting Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal programs, for a three-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, for the County's Fiscal Years ending 12/31/17, 12/31/18, and 12/31/19, for the amount of \$19.000.00 for the Fiscal Year ending 12/31/17, \$19,000.00 for the Fiscal Year ending 12/31/19, for a total amount not to exceed \$57,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary to forgo the aforementioned renewals and that the aforementioned professional service contract with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to provide the development of a central services cost allocation plan for the County to support and administer Federal programs, for a three-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/19, for the amount of \$19,000.00 for the Fiscal Year ending 12/31/17, \$19,000.00 for the Fiscal Year ending 12/31/19, for a total amount not to exceed \$57,000.00.
