 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5502.41 provides for the Ohio Mutual Aid Compact to complement existing mutual aid agreements to allow a political subdivision to request assistance with planned events such as the RNC and receive assistance from any other political subdivision in the state; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5502.29 permits an Ohio political subdivision to enter into mutual aid agreements with political subdivisions in Ohio and in neighboring states for assistance with a planned event; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the City of Cleveland, the County of Summit is willing to provide, through the County Sheriff's Office, the assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment for public safety-related aid and assistance during the RNC; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland and the County of Summit wish to enter into an intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement to outline the terms and conditions for the County Sheriff's Office to provide the assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment for public safety-related aid and assistance during the RNC; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement the City of Cleveland and the County for the County Sheriff's Office to provide the aforementioned assistance during the RNC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement the City of Cleveland for the County Sheriff's Office to provide assistance of law enforcement personnel and/or equipment for public safety-related aid and assistance during the 2016 Republican National Convention ("RNC") to be held in Cleveland during the week of July 18, 2016. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement is hereby approved with any changes approved by the County Executive that are not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County. The approval of those changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the intergovernmental cooperative/mutual aid agreement.
