8 **A Resolution, authorizing the County Executive to execute Amendment #1 to a subgrant**
9 **agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for grants for the**
10 **operation of workforce development activities for Local Area 2 received by the County**
11 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services during State Fiscal Year 2016 (7/1/16**
12 **to 6/30/17), and setting forth the conditions and reliances upon which the County is**
13 **entering into said Amendment #1, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
14 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

15
16 WHEREAS, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Ohio
17 Department of Job and Family Services may only make grants to counties through subgrant
18 agreements described in that Section; and

20 WHEREAS, in conformance with Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio
21 Department of Job and Family Services developed a standard subgrant agreement to be executed
22 by the Executive or Commissioners of each county prior to receiving Department of Job and
23 Family Services grant funds; and

25 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-357, this Council approved a subgrant
26 agreement for the operation of workforce development activities received by the County
27 Department of Job and Family Services for State Fiscal Year ("SFY") 2016 (7/1/15 to 6/30/16);

30 WHEREAS, the County Department of Job and Family Services has received from the
31 State a standard Amendment #1 to the aforementioned subgrant agreement to continue the same
32 for SFY 2017 (7/1/16 through 6/30/17) that sets forth the rights and responsibilities of the Ohio
33 Department of Job and Family Services and the County Department of Job and Family Services
34 in relation to any grant for workforce development activities, including, but not limited to, the
35 Workforce Investment Opportunity Act, the Wagner-Peyser Act, and Temporary Assistance to
36 Needy Families programs relating to workforce development, that are awarded for SFY 2017;

39 WHEREAS, given the uncertainty that exists about the State of Ohio's ability to
40 implement its new Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program ("CCMEP")
41 using Workforce Investment Opportunity Act funds, it is necessary to condition the County's
42 execution of the subgrant agreement on (i) the State of Ohio's implementation and operation of
43 CCMEP in the manner and fashion identified in certain correspondence between the State of
44 Ohio and the U.S. Department of Labor, attached hereto as Exhibits A and B, (ii) the
45 representations in the correspondence from Ohio Department of Job and Family Services
46 Director Cynthia Dungey, attached hereto as Exhibit C, and (iii) the State's implementation and
47 operation of CCMEP in a manner and fashion consistent with the Workforce Innovation
48 Opportunity Act and further guidance and directive from the U.S. Department of Labor; and

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50 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
51 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
52 Executive to execute said Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement for SFY 2017;

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5 WHEREAS, in determining that authorizing the County Executive to execute said
6 Amendment #1 is in the best interest of the County, this Council has relied upon the
7 representations made by the State of Ohio in the correspondence attached hereto as Exhibits B
8 and C; and

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
11 of Ohio, that:

13 SECTION 1
14

15 The County Executive is authorized to execute Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement
16 with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for grants for the operation of workforce
17 development activities received by the County Department of Job and Family Services for State
18 Fiscal Year 2017 (7/1/16 through 6/30/17). A copy of said Amendment #1 to the subgrant
19 agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit D and incorporated herein by reference.
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21 SECTION 2
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23 The County Executive is further authorized and directed to communicate to the State of
24 Ohio Department of Job and Family Services upon execution and submittal of said Amendment
25 #1, that the execution of the same is conditioned on the conditions set forth above, that the
26 County has relied on the representations made by the State of Ohio in the correspondence
27 attached hereto as Exhibits B and C, and that the County will construe the State's
28 issuance/release of funds to implement CCMEP to the Area 2 WDB, its Fiscal Agent, and/or its
29 member Counties- Summit and Medina- to constitute acknowledgment, acceptance and consent
30 to the conditions and reliances set forth above.

32 SECTION 3

34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to
36 immediately execute said Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement so that the County
37 Executive's Department of Job and Family Services is eligible to be awarded grant funds from
38 the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for SFY 2017.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
44 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 SECTION 5
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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirement, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


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
