WHEREAS, sanitary sewer easements are needed for the Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project (Q-948), in Springfield Township, in Council District 8; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, has been unable to acquire the easement necessary for the Project on PPN Nos. 51-04790 and 51-04786 because the owner of these contiguous parcels, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. has refused or failed to respond to the County's Notice of Intent to Acquire and Good Faith Offer made on or around September 24, 2015, after numerous attempts by the County's agent to obtain a response; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said right-of-way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section 6117.39 and Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

# SECTION 1

DECOLUTION NO

The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate an easement for sanitary sewer purposes on the real property described by Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution, said property being owned by Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., located in Springfield Township, in Council District 8.

# **SECTION 2**

The County Prosecutor is hereby directed to prepare and file on behalf of Summit County, Ohio, proceedings for appropriation, under the provisions of Chapters 6117 and 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, of said easement.

# **SECTION 3**

The County Executive, through the County Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to draw by voucher upon the County of Summit and pay into the Court of Common Pleas at the time of the filing of a complaint for the appropriation of an easement on said real property, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, an amount to exceed \$1,078.00.
