A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related medical services, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.				
	WHEREAS, Section 341.12 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the sheriff of a county where there is not adequate jailing capacity or staffing to convey inmates to a jail located in another county; and			
	WHEREAS, after closing a wing of the Summit County Jail, the Sheriff has begun sending inmates to jails in surrounding counties and municipalities, such as Stark County,			

Geauga County, and the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit exempts from competitive bidding contracts with other governmental entities, including those that would contract with the County to house inmates in their jails; and

WHEREAS, given the nature of the fluidity of inmate boarding needs and related medical services, it is impossible to ascertain how much the County will ultimately spend with each governmental entity or medical service provider, thereby necessitating a super specific purchase order for these items with a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$280,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 1, 2016, awarded a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related medical services, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related medical expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said super specific purchase order.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately allowing the Sheriff to continue boarding inmates in other county and municipal jails.
