WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Finance and Budget and the Board of Control have previously approved purchases by the Court of Common Pleas - General Division, Adult Probation Department from the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in the aggregate amount of \$35,000.00 for calendar year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas- General Division, Adult Probation Department anticipates additional purchases from Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in an additional amount not to exceed \$40,000.00, for a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 in calendar year 2016; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize purchases by the Court of Common Pleas - General Division, Adult Probation Department from the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 in calendar year 2016;
