A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation for certain contributions related to the demolition and remediation of all structures at 1621 Flickinger Road, in the Village of Lakemore, Council District 8, and more commonly known as the former Edwin Shaw Hospital, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County is the owner of certain real property located at 1621 Flickinger Road in the Village of Lakemore, Council District 8, and more commonly known as the former Edwin Shaw Hospital (the "Edwin Shaw Property"), whereupon the County, and later Akron General Medical Center, operated a tuberculosis hospital, and later a rehabilitation hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Edwin Shaw Property is the location of several structures, including a large former hospital, powerhouse, laundry facility, the Dobkin center building, and several "cottages" or multi-family housing/residential rehabilitation units, along with tunnels and other miscellaneous structures; and

WHEREAS, since the Edwin Shaw Property became vacant at the end of 2009, when Akron General Medical Center moved the rehabilitation hospital operations to another location, the County has made numerous attempts to make productive use of the Edwin Shaw Property, but the existence of the buildings, which are old and in a state of disrepair, has repeatedly impeded progress and deterred potential buyers or lessees; and

WHEREAS, the structures located on the property are too numerous and isolated to entirely secure, and the buildings have been subjected to repeated break-ins, theft, vandalism and other damage; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended demolishing the structures on the Edwin Shaw Property in order to (i) develop the remaining land into a productive use, (ii) eliminate the repetitive break-ins, theft, vandalism and other damage in order to prevent injury to a person illegally on the property and to reduce the strain that such activity places on the police in the Village of Lakemore, and (iii) prevent the decaying buildings from further depressing the real estate market in the Village of Lakemore; and

WHEREAS, this Council, pursuant to Resolution 2016-229, has authorized the County Executive to enter into a contract with SAFECO Environmental, Inc. for the demolition and remediation of the structures on the Edwin Shaw Property in an amount not to exceed \$850,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive further intends to contact with a separate company to represent the County in ensuring that all demolition and remediation work on the Edwin Shaw Property is done consistent with all State of Ohio and federal environmental laws, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.00; and

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WHEREAS, the County Executive anticipates that unforeseen conditions on the Edwin Shaw Property could result in an additional \$100,000.00 in costs related to the demolition and remediation of the structures; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive anticipates that, collectively, the cost to demolish and remediate the structures on the Edwin Shaw Property should not exceed \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed entering into a Cooperative Agreement with the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("Summit County Land Bank") whereby the Summit County Land Bank agrees to contribute one-half of the total cost to demolish and remediate the structures at the Edwin Shaw Property, up to the amount of \$500,000.00, which will be paid in five equal annual installments commencing December 1, 2017 and continuing until December 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the proposed Cooperative Agreement, upon a subsequent sale of the Edwin Shaw Property, the County will pay to the Summit County Land Bank a sum equal to one-half of the sales price, not to exceed the amount paid by the Summit County Land Bank to the County for demolition and remediation; and

 WHEREAS, the proposed Cooperative Agreement with the Summit County Land Bank assists the County with the costs of the demolition and remediation of the structures on the Edwin Shaw Property while also fulfilling the purpose of the Summit County Land Bank to eliminate abandoned, vacant and blighted properties in the County, in particular in areas with struggling real-estate markets like the Village of Lakemore; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County, to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned Cooperative Agreement with the Summit County Land Bank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the Summit County Land Bank whereby the Summit County Land Bank will pay to the County one-half of the total cost to demolish and remediate the structures at the Edwin Shaw Property, up to the amount of \$500,000.00, which will be paid in five equal annual installments commencing December 1, 2017 and continuing until December 1, 2021, and whereby, upon a subsequent sale of the Edwin Shaw Property, the County will pay to the Summit County Land Bank a sum equal to one-half of the sales price, not to exceed the amount paid by the Summit County Land Bank to the County for demolition and remediation.

SECTION 2

 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to immediately allow the County Executive to proceed with executing the Cooperative Agreement prior to the commencement of the demolition and remediation of the structures.
