A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to apply for and accept an award from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration of a Public Works and Federal Economic Adjustment Assistance Program, planning grant, in the amount of \$125,000.00 with a local in-kind match requirement of \$143,200.00, and designating Holly Miller as the authorized representative to act on behalf of the County for purposes of the proposed award, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive in collaboration with the City of Fairlawn, City of Akron and Greater Akron Chamber, has applied for a Public Works and Federal Economic Adjustment Assistance Program, planning grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (the "EDA") and has been notified that the County's application has been reviewed for merit and selected for further consideration; and

WHEREAS, the planning grant will be used to fund a feasibility study of the potential expansion of a high-speed fiber network to 14 Job Hubs, which are concentrated areas of traded-sector economic activity that are focal points of economic development strategy, and 16 Opportunity Zones – economically distressed census tracts that carry incentives for investment within the County; and

WHEREAS, the notice letter provided by the EDA requests a governing board resolution that identifies an authorized representative to act on behalf of the county for purposes of the proposed award; and

WHEREAS, the Executive would like to designate Holly Miller, a Senior Administrator in the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development as the authorized representative to act on behalf of the County for purposes of the proposed award; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to apply for and accept an award from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration of a Public Works and Federal Economic Adjustment Assistance Program planning grant and to designate Holly Miller as the authorized representative to act on behalf of the County for purposes of the proposed award;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

# SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for and accept an award from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration of a Public Works and Federal Economic Adjustment Assistance Program planning grant in the amount of \$125,000.00 with a local in-kind match requirement of \$143,200.00.
