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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, an amendment to a grant agreement with the United Way of Summit & Medina Counties (the "United Way"), in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, to be paid by Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") and/or Title XX funds which will be used provide rental and mortgage assistance to qualified County residents, necessary due to the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic and to extend the agreement through 9/30/21, the end of Federal Fiscal Year 2021.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County's financial assistance to Summit County residents who have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

EXECUTIVE

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
